

Policy on transferring from the certificate program to the LLM by course work

1. Applications will be considered by the graduate studies committee.
2. No application will be considered unless the applicant has completed all four courses in the certificate program and the grades for those courses are available to the committee.
3. An application to transfer must include a proposed major paper (including title, statement of research question and discussion, maximum of one page) and a proposed supervisor.
4. The committee may ask for additional references to support the application.
5. The committee will ordinarily consider applications at the same time and in competition with applications for regular admission to the LLM program. Accordingly, an application may be held until that time. There is no right to transfer to the LLM by course work program simply on the basis of satisfactory completion of courses in the certificate program; much will depend upon the pool of eligible candidates.
